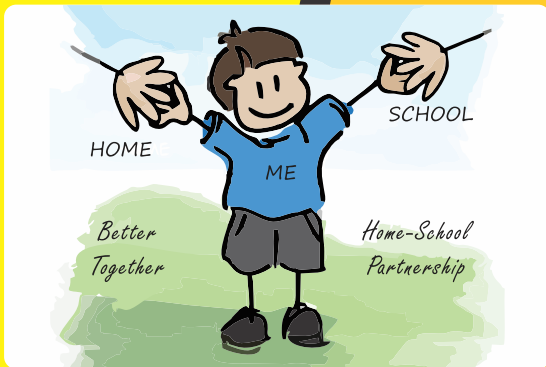

# Home School Agreement

## As a school we will:

- Provide a safe and happy environment where all children are valued, respected, listened to and immersed in the language and cultures of Wales.
- Provide excellent teaching and an engaging and creative curriculum to meet the needs of all children.
- Provide as much support as we can to help your child meet their full potential in all aspects of school life.
- Regularly share the progress of your child through appropriate means.
- Support your child to develop a moral and ethical compass for life enabling them to grow up and be the best person they can be.
- Achieve high standards of behaviour by providing opportunities for children to develop positive social relationships, self-esteem and a sense of responsibility.
- Teach your child to develop a positive attitude to one another.
- Respect the confidentiality of information regarding each child.
- Provide information to you about our school through relevant means.
- Provide opportunities to nurture individual talents and interests.
- Maintain positive relationships between home and school – children learn best when home and school work together.

## The responsibilities of the parents/guardians:

- To explain to the child what school is for and your decision to give your child the valuable 'gift' of the Welsh language.
- To help your children with their learning by showing an interest in what your child has done in school, sharing reading book, looking after and returning borrowed books and resources, attending Parents' Evenings, and supporting your child with homework.
- To support the school – any worries or concerns should be shared privately with the class teacher in the first instance. Please don't voice your concerns in front of your child or other children in a public place or on social media. Make an appointment, we are always willing to listen and come to a shared understanding. If the parent criticises the school, the child will do the same, and this will affect their ability to learn.
- To send the children to school on time every day, when they're fit to come, and to avoid taking holidays during term time.
- To send your child to school ready to learn – children need to concentrate in order to learn, therefore need to be fit and well, to have had enough sleep (approx. 10-11hrs), to have eaten and be suitably dressed.
- To communicate with the school any special needs, special circumstances at home that may affect your child's learning.
- To support the school's policies and guidelines e.g. behaviour, attendance.
- Regularly read information from the school e.g. newsletters, emails, texts (download ParentMail app)
